cry -- was/were cryying

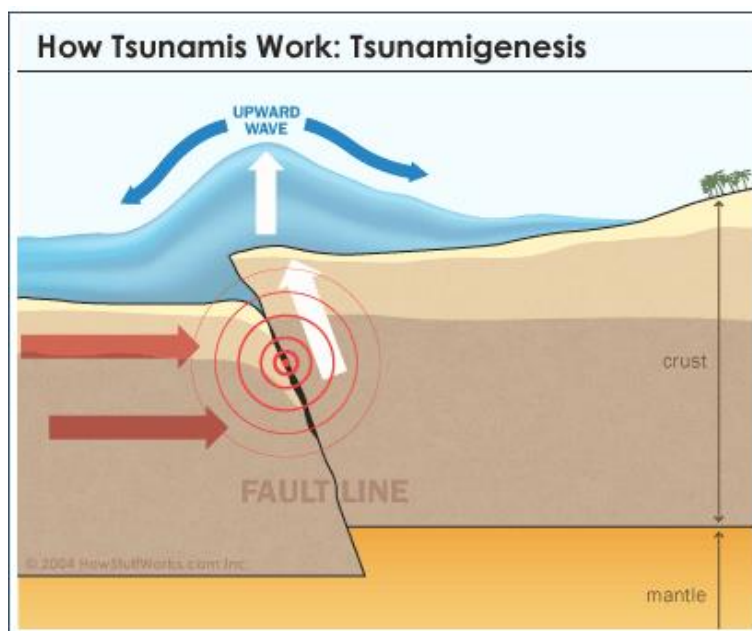
