- **El tiempo verbal de la respuesta debe coincidir con el tiempo verbal de la pregunta.**

PRESENT SIMPLE en la pregunta: Is/Are or Does/Do..... V? P.S. en la respuesta: (is/are) or (V-s/-es/-ies).....

PRESENT CONTINUOUS en la pregunta: Is/Are V-ing.....? P.C. en la respuesta: (is/are V-ing).....

- La **respuesta** debe ser **coherente** con lo que se pide en la pregunta.
